

By combining different size kitchen panels 48" or 32" you can achieve a variety of effective lengths of your kitchen island. Listed below are the various combinations and the effective length. Remember that since they interlock by 4 inches, 4 inches of length is lost when aligned.

Another factor when creating shapes such as an L or a U, is your interior sides will always be one panel shorter than your outer wall. If you have an outer wall made of only 48" panels, you will have to have a depth(side panel) of 48" in order for the interior walls to work. See diagram at bottom.
